The Orthomerica STARsummit

Bionic took the opportunity to send 5 clinicians to the Orthomerica STARsummit in Orlando, Florida in October.

The Orthomerica STARsummit includes 2 days full of presentations including a variety of direct patient care examples, research, outcome based studies, and clinical perspectives for non-synostotic and synostotic cases along with learning about the new Orthomerica products. The team had the opportunity to tour the Orthomerica Fabrication Facility where they saw the entire process for cranial remolding fabrication

Kayla and Emily were provided the opportunity to present on their own research: Starband & Cranial Base Correction. Their research found that correction of cranial base asymmetry, upper facial difference, orbitotragial depth and ear shift is possible regardless of age; however age at the start of treatment was correlated with greater improvement specifically for facial and cranial base measurements. CRO treatment that started before 6 months of age had more cranial base correction then those that started after 6 months of age.

While Libbi & Kayla have attended the STARsummit before, each year they are always expanding their knowledge and learning new "tricks of the trade" to bring back to their team. This year they shared this experience with Brian & Madhu who were able to attend for the first time. Our Bionic employees were able to network with nearly 150 clinicians, physicians, nurse practitioners, and O&P students from across the US as well as 20 countries around the world. The Bionic team learned new ways to incorporate adjustment techniques, repositioning approaches, and communication with referral sources into their clinics. All 5 employees became certified to now provide the



Employee of the Month: Beti Gollis!




