

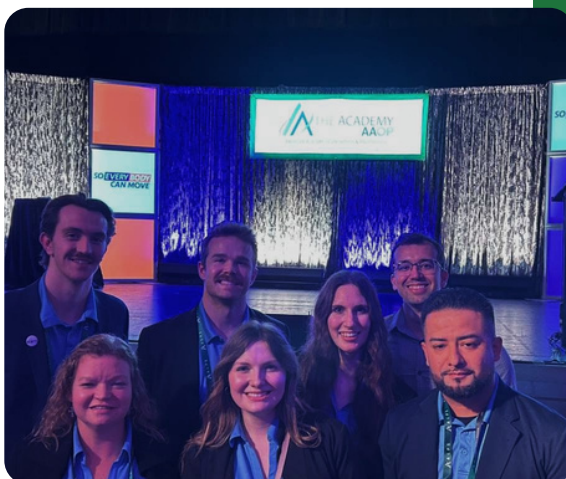

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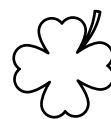
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American Academy of Orthotists and Prosthetists (AAOP)

We appreciated the chance to share our values, culture, and career opportunities, and we look forward to staying in touch with the many great people we met.

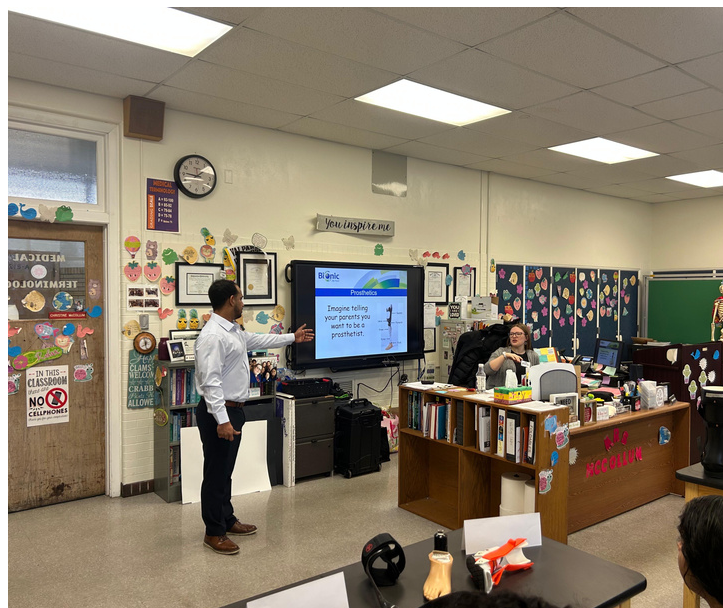


WHAT'S HAPPENING AT BIONIC

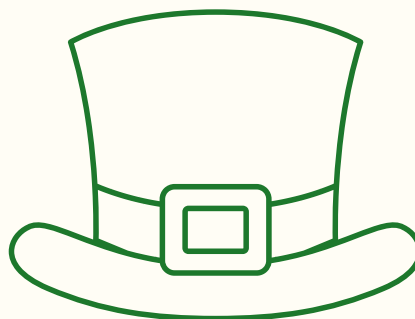
