Cranial remolding treatment is a niche part of the orthotics field and is something that she has learned through on-the-job experience. Valentine's Dipped Rice Krispies Treats

Ingredients

- 3 tablespoons margarine or butter
- 1 package (10 oz) regular marshmallows or 4 cups miniature marshmallows
- 6 cups crisped rice cereal (aka Rice Krispies)
- Candy melts or white chocolate chips
- Food coloring, if desired
- Sprinkles, of course

Directions

- Melt the margarine or butter in a large saucepan over low heat. Add the marshmallows and stir until completely melted. Remove from heat.
- Mix in the crisped rice cereal. Stir until well coated.
- Spread the mixture using a buttered spatula or waxed paper evenly into a rimmed baking sheet coated with cooking spray. Cut the treats into heart shapes with a 2- 3-inch cookie cutter when cooled.
- Melt the candy melts according to the package directions. Stir in a few drops of food coloring.
- Dip one edge of the heart into melted chocolate and decorate with sprinkles.

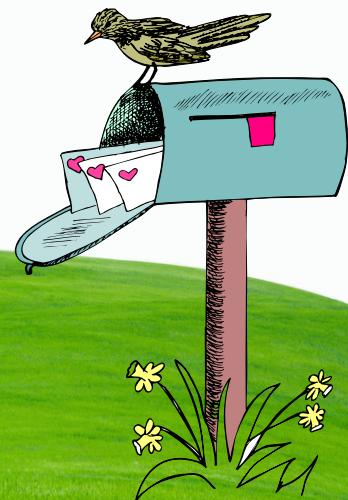
