SUPERBOWL HOSTING TIPS

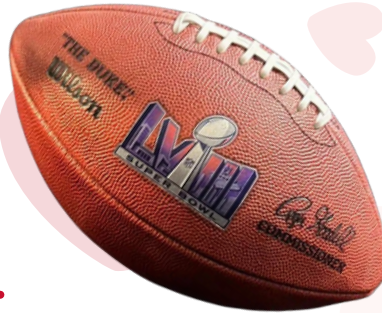


1. DECORATIONS
